In the quarterfinals of No. 1 doubles, the FSU team of Cheryl Cordes and Gigi Boesch defeated USF's Diane Gondolfo and Denise Finneran 6-2, 6-2 to advance to the semifinals. There, FSU won 6-2, 1-6, 6-4 against another team from USF. In the final Boesch-Cordes defeated Tuberville-Kolankiewicz of Florida International University 6-2, 7-5.
