

FSU women third in Metro; Pollack figures in two wins

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — Behind Debbie Pollack's wins in No. 3 singles and No. 3 doubles, the Florida State women's tennis team defeated Virginia Tech 7-2 on Saturday to place third in the Metro Conference championships.

South Carolina defeated Tulane 6-3 for the Metro title.

Pollack, the only senior on the Lady Seminole squad, beat Anne Howard 6-2, 6-3 to finish the season with a 20-6 mark. Pollack teamed with Jenny Cerino to defeat Sue Gutch and Maria Garcia 6-3, 6-4.

FSU finished the season at 12-14, but coach Anne Rizza said the
