BAKER WINS TENNIS TITLE - Florida State's Buffy Baker won her first intercollegiate tennis title at the Samford Sandestin Invitational last weekend in Sandestin, Baker, the Lady Seminoles' No. 1 player and the No. 1 seed in the tournament, defeated second-seeded Kristy Kottich of Georgia Tech. They split the first two sets 3-6 and 6-3, and with darkness settling in, they decided the match with a tiebreaker that Baker won 8-6. In other action, Lady Seminole player Keri Preng reached the finals of the singles consolation where she lost to seventh-seeded Pilar Morono of Auburn. FSU's Lori Webster and Nicki Ivy took the doubles consolation title. Florida State will compete in its first dual matches of the fall season Oct. 27 against South Florida and Oct. 28 against Rollins. Both matches will be played in Tampa. The team also plays in the Rolex Regional Qualifier Nov. 10-12 at FSU's Donald Loucks courts.
