## FSU's team bows

and Juul got was ...verpowered — in straight sets — by the fourth-ranked team in the country.

"They were just powerful, real-

ly strong," Sowell said.

It didn't take long for Phebus and Yaroshuk to eliminate the No. 10 team of Juul and Sowell with a 6-1, 6-1 victory in Wednesday's opening round of the doubles portion of the NCAA Women's Tennis Championships at Scott Speicher Tennis Center.

"We wanted to do a lot better in this tournament," said Sowell, who had earlier defeated Texas' Farley Taylor 7-5, 7-6 in singles. "This doesn't reflect the kind of year we had."

The two couldn't counter Phebus and Yaroshuk's deadly serve and return.

"It was just tough to get into a groove," Juul said. "Points were ending so fast. They were really on. They didn't miss."

Phebus and Yaroshuk say when their serve and return are clicking, they're unbeatable.

Phebus, who won last year's national doubles championship with Susie Starrett, hopes to continue playing well.

"If that continues," Phebus said,

"it's going to be interesting to see what happens."

Phebus is also the defending singles national champion.

Phebus and Yaroshuk play Florida's Bonnie Bleecker and Divya Merchant today. The winner advances to Friday's quarterfinals.

Yaroshuk said she's determined to help Phebus win consecutive doubles titles.

"I'm just trying to keep her role going," Yaroshuk said. "I'm trying to do everything in my power to get her another (title) and my first."

One of the keys is playing as

few three-set matches as possible in such hot conditions. Temperatures have been in the 90s throughout the tournament.

"I wouldn't say it (Wednesday's match) was a breeze, but it was nice not having to go three sets," Phebus said.

Phebus and Yaroshuk had already competed in the team tournament as UCLA defeated Vanderbilt and Arizona. UCLA lost to Florida in the semifinals.

"We had a few matches under our belt," Yorashuk said.

### Sowell's run ends in Round 3

Florida State's Lori Sowell sat down heavily in a chair, her face the shade of the bill of her FSU cap.

Her season ended on Thursday in a 7-5, 6-3 loss to Ania Bleszynski of Stanford in the third round of the NCAA Women's Tennis Championships at Scott Speicher Tennis Center.

While Sowell won Thursday's opening match with Arizona's Stephanie Sammaritano, 6-4, 7-5, it came at quite a price.

Down 5-3 in the second set, Sowell put on a stirring sprint to the finish to pull out the match, earning her All-American status for a second straight year.

"Lori struggled a little bit today," said Sowell's coach, Alice Reen. "To get through that first match, she had to make a lot of adjustments and it took a lot out of her."

What that match didn't take out of her, the afternoon showdown with Stanford's Bleszynski did.

Just looking across the net, Sowell knew she had quite a task at hand. Not only was the 6-foot-2 Bleszynski imposing, she had a fearsome serve, powerful ground strokes and a No. 7 ranking.

Sowell, ranked 31st, built a 5-3 lead in the first set with a nice mix of drop shots and a couple of aces.

But once Bleszynski started drilling her serves home and keeping Sowell on the baseline with boomer after boomer, she swept the next four games to win the set.

In the second set, Sowell battled her as hard as anybody could. She took a 3-1 lead in the second set on grit alone and there was some optimism in the FSU camp.

But Sowell didn't win another game.
