Cavaliers Lose to Florida State 7-2 in Women's Tennis

CHARLOTTESVILLE, VA.—The University of Virginia women's tennis team lost to Florida State 7-2 this afternoon in Atlantic Coast Conference action at the Sheridan G. Snyder Tennis Center at Lady Astor. The loss was the Cavaliers' third in a row and they fall to 8-8 overall and 1-4 in the ACC. Florida State improves to 10-9 overall and 6-2 in the ACC with the win.

The Lady Seminoles clinched the match early by taking all six singles matches, including five two-set wins.

Virginia rebounded somewhat by winning two of three doubles matches. Stacy Gingold and Emily Hill teamed at #1 to down Ann Olsson and Lori Sowell 8-7. Paige Boiko and Kendall White won their sixth consecutive match with an 8-4 triumph over Kia Asberg and Sasha Hanna at #2.

The Cavaliers return to action at home against Maryland on Wednesday (April 9) at 2:30 PM.
