Match Notes: Number next to each player is ranking by Intercollegiate Tennis Association ... Iowa improves its record to 17-8 on the season and faces Notre Dame in the second round on Sunday at 11:00 a.m. ... the Hawkeyes are ranked No. 38 in the country ... Florida State finishes the season with a 21-7 record and is ranked No. 19 in the country ... Iowa rallied from 0-4 down to win the final five matches for the win in their first NCAA appearance ... Florida State falls to 0-5 in its five NCAA championship appearances ... the Lady Seminoles used wins at Nos. 4, 6, 5 and 1 singles to jump out a to 4-0 lead ... Dawaf broke serve at 5-4 in the third set for Iowa's first point after losing nine match points while leading 5-0 in the third set ... Neykova and Wiegler won the final four games of the pro set at No. 1 doubles after falling behind 5-7, tying the match at 4-4 ... Johnson and Wolverton held serve at 6-7 and 7-8 to send the clinching match into a tiebreaker ... that pair jumped out a 6-0 lead and held on for a 7-4 win in the tiebreaker to send Iowa into the second round ... Iowa has never beaten Notre Dame in four meetings, including an 8-1 loss earlier this season at Notre Dame ... Florida State's last loss was to Wake Forest 5-4 in the ACC championship semifinals after also leading 4-2 following singles.
