Florida State Women's Tennis Defeats South Florida 4-3

Seminoles back on a winning track after victory on the road.

TALLAHASSEE, FL.—The Florida State women's tennis team ended a two-match losing streak today by defeating the No. 37 ranked University of South Florida in Tampa 4-3. With the win the 33-ranked Seminoles improve to 4-5 on the season.

In doubles play Jessica Balbuena teamed with Samantha Schoeffel at the No. 2 spot to take the 8-3 win over USF's Genevieve Houle and Natalie Schwartz. Marina Raic and Christina Denny clinched the doubles point for the Seminoles with an 8-4 win over Aschlee Callahan and Ildiko Zubor at the No. 3 position.

Florida State then moved on to a 3-0 lead as No. 2 Christina Denny and No. 5 Samantha Schoeffel won their singles matches in straight sets. USF's Tina Harrison got the Bulls on the board with the upset victory over FSU's Alida Gallovits at the No. 1 singles position, but just a few minutes later Nanette Duxin clinched the match for the 'Noles with a 6-4, 6-1 win over Genevieve Houle at No. 2.

The next match for the women's tennis team will be at home against Michigan State on Tuesday March 6^{th} at 2:30 p.m.

> Florida State ended a two-match losing streak while extending South Florida's losing streak to three, winning a 4-3 match today at the USF Varsity Tennis Courts.

After taking the number two and three doubles match to pick up a single point, Florida Statewon at number three and number 5 singles to jump out to a 3-0 lead. USF's Tina Harrison then got the Bulls on the board at number one singles when she knocked off Alida Gallovits, ranked 38th in the latest ITA poll, 6-3, 6-3.

But, just a few minutes later, FSU's Nanette Duxin clinched the win for the 'Noles with a 6-4, 6-1 win over Genevieve Houle, 6-4, 6-1.

USF (2-4) did manage to win the final two singles matches at numbers four and six, both in three-set fashion. At number four, USF's Jennifer Sinclair came back from a 4-2 deficit in the third set to win 1-6, 6-4, 7-5.
