Boone Records Fall

RICHMOND, Ky. -Records were falling like raindrops in the third annual Becky Boone Relays, a women's track meet won by Michigan State here Saturday.

In all, 10 standards were broken with members of the Chicago State team surpassing four of the marks — Veronica Harris in the 100 and 220, Teela Schemadwai in the 440 and its 880 - yard medley relay team.

Michigan State won only one event, the 400-yard relay in record time of 50.7 seconds, but had enough depth to edge Illinois State for team honors, 63-55. Illinois took third. The only Kentuckian claiming a victory was Centre College's Elizabeth Johnson in the 400meter hurdles. Team standings — 1.
