

## Seminole ladies cop track title

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.—Florida State's women's track team broke six school records in finishing first in a seven-team field at the University of Tennessee All-Comers Track Meet at Stokely Athletic Center here Friday.

The Lady Seminoles broke two school marks while placing first and second in the shot put. Kim Travers threw 49.9¼ and Vicky Smith had a throw of 40.7½ in the event.

Kim Sorgel set a school record placing third in the 60-yard high hurdles with a time of 8.7 seconds and Debbie Patterson set a school mark in the 60-yard dash with a time of 7.3 seconds.

Laura Ledbetter, who placed fourth in the mile run set an FSU record with a time of 5:28.4 in that event. Laura Heffernin's 5:32.4 was also a school mark in that event.

The Lady Seminole mile relay team not only broke a school indoor record, but had the fastest time of any Lady Seminole outfit ever. They placed second in the event with a time of 4:14.5.

The Lady Seminoles finished just ahead of the University of Tennessee and Eastern Kentucky in the meet.
