

Lady thinclads fall

The University of Florida defeated Florida State's lady Seminole track team 55-31 in the season opener for the FSU squad here Saturday.

Florida's women won every running event and took first and second in the 100 and 220 yard dashes.

Senior Laura Ledbetter of FSU shaved two seconds off her old school record of 2:22.5 in the 880 as she placed second. Vickie Smith broke her previous school record in the 100-meter hurdles with a time of 15.6 although she too came in second.

Freshman Debbie Patterson bested Ledbetter's mark in the 440 with a 60.5 clocking.

FSU's strong suit was the long jump and the shot put as two freshmen took the honors. Kim Soergel, playing with an injury, broke a school record in the long jump with a leap of 17-8. Kim Travers registered a new school mark in the shot put with a heave of 43-2—in an event which hasn't seen a record since 1969.
