

## Women set 3 records

GAINESVILLE — Florida State's women's track team set three school records at the Lady Gator Florida Relays here Saturday afternoon.

Mary-Catherine Kelly was the Lady Seminoles' only winner on the afternoon, taking the 400-meter run with an FSU-record time of 57.8.

Kelly also ran the anchor leg of the mile relay team that set a school record with a second place time of 4:00.5. Joining her in that effort were Kim Soergel, Leslie Sullivan and Nancy McCormick.

The other school record was McCormick's fifth place time of 4:39.6 in the 1500-meter run.

Kelly also placed fourth in the long jump (18 feet, 5½ inches) and joined Soergel, Karen Keith and Roz Anderson for a fifth place finish in the 400-meter relay.

In the shot put, FSU's Vickie Smith was second (44-10½) and Kim Travers was third. In the discus, Travers was third (133-6) and Smith was fourth (127-5).

Also, Nancy Townsend placed third in the high jump with a leap of 5 feet, 2 inches.
