

Women set FSU records

LOS ANGELES — Four Florida State women raced to a seventh-place finish in the two-mile relay Saturday to highlight the Seminoles' appearance in the AIAW Nationals hosted by UCLA.

Nancy McCormac, Mary-Catherine Kelly, Laura Ledbetter and Bev Cox set a new school record of 9:02.26 in the race.

FSU failed to score any points in the meet, won by UCLA, but did get three other good performances.

Kelly finished fourth in the heats of the 400-meter intermediate hurdles, tying her school record of 1:01.60. Ledbetter set a new school standard of 2:11.88 in the 800-meter run, to place 13th, while Vickie Smith placed 14th in the shotput with a toss of 44-feet 9-inches.
