ATHENS, Ga. — The Florida State women's track team won eight of 10 events Saturday, establishing two AIAW national qualifying times in the non-scored Georgia Spec Invitational.

Tonja Brown won the 100-meter hurdles in 14.06 seconds and set a track record of 58.97 in the 400-meter hurdles.

The team of Esmeralda Garcia, Alice Bennett, Randy Givens and Marita Payne ran a 45.34 to win the 400-meter relay, then qualified for AIAW nationals with their 1:40.77 clocking in the sprint medley relay. Angela Wright also qualified for the AIAW meet by winning the 800-meter dash in 2:11.13.
