4 more women qualify for meet

GAINESVILLE — Florida State had seven first-place finishes and qualified four more women for the AIAW National Meet Saturday in the women's division of the non-scored Florida Fasttimes Indoor Invitational.

The Lady Seminoles have now qualified 14 people in 18 individual events and three relay teams for the national meet, to be held in Cedar Falls, Iowa, next weekend.

Jeanette Wood and Margaret Coomber both set national times in the half mile in the meet at the University of Florida. Wood finished the event in 2:10.6, while Coomber finished in 2:10.9. Marita Payne and Angela Wright had the other two standards in the 300-meters, with Payne winning in 37.84 and Wright finishing in 38.67.
