Florida St. places 4th in AIAW

CEDAR FALLS, Iowa — The Florida State women's track team finished in fourth place with 36 points at the AIAW National Indoor Track and Field Championships Saturday.

Nebraska won the meet with 84 points, followed by Tennessee with 64 and Virginia with 57 points.

"We could have had a chance for second place had we run better," said FSU coach Gary Winckler. "But there was no way we could have beaten Nebraska. They are awesome."

Overall, the Lady Seminoles brought home eight individual All-American awards and another 12 for relays. The top eight finishers in each event were named All-Americans.

Marita Payne earned three of those All-American honors, two of them individual. And Margaret Coomber, Carla Borvicka, Janette Wood and Ovrill Brown set a meet and collegiate record in the two-mile relay Friday, winning in 8:47.2.

The Lady Seminoles 880-yard relay team of Kim Parrish, Payne, Alice Bennett and Randy Givens ran a 1:38.80 to finish second in that event. FSU's mile relay squad, consisting of Tonja Brown, Scooby Golden, Angie Wright and Brown, finished sixth in 3:48.89 after dropping the baton

In the 300-yard dash, Givens, a sophomore, placed second in 34.49. Nebraska's Merlene Ottey won the race in 32.63, breaking the world record for that event, while Payne was fourth in 34.77. Payne also ran a seventh place 6.96 in the 60-yard dash.

In the 60-yard hurdles, Carolyn Faison finished sixth in 7.98 and Brown was seventh in 7.99.

Coomber and Wright both broke school records in the meet. Coomber finished eighth in the 1,000-yard run in 2:41.73 and Wright ran a sixth-place 55.16 in the 440-yard dash. Brown also finished fifth in 1:21.73 in the 600-yard run.
