In the 300-yard dash, Givens, a sophomore, placed second in 34.49. Nebraska's Merlene Ottey won the race in 32.63, breaking the world rec-ord for that event, while Payne was fourth in 34.77. Payne also ran a seventh place 6.96 in the 60-yard dash.

In the 60-yard hurdles, Carolyn Faison finished sixth in 7.98 and Brown was seventh in 7.99.
