

FSU Ladies win tourney

Florida State's women swept six matches in two days of competition to capture the 6th annual Lady Seminole Invitational Volleyball tournament Saturday at FSU.

After falling 6-15 to second place Miami Dade South in the first game of the final match, the FSU spikers ward off a tough Miami Dade attack and rallied to win the second game 16-14. Led by senior Joann Sharpe and substitute Barbara Harris, the highly psyched Lady Seminoles finalized all hope for Miami Dade's Jaguars and copped the final game of the match 15-7 to win the tournament for the first time since 1971.

"We played more offensively," said FSU coach Billie Jones. "The first game our offense broke at the net, and that's what hurt us."

Finishing behind Miami Dade South, was third place team Florida International University, who defeated top seed West Georgia College.
