

FSU still alive in volleyball play

Florida State is one of six teams still alive after the first day of play in the Lady Seminole Invitational volleyball tournament at Tully Gym.

The field of 12 teams was cut in half Friday, and the remaining six squads will battle through a double-elimination bracket beginning at 10 a.m. today. The championship game is set for around 5:30.

Florida Tech is the No. 1 seed among the remaining teams. Also, there's Mississippi University for Women, Miami Dade South, South Carolina, North Carolina and FSU.
