

FSU is unbeaten in volleyball meet

Florida State, Central Florida and Miami remained the only three unbeaten teams in the Florida State Lady Seminole Invitational volleyball tournament after play on Friday.

All three were 4-0 going into today's play.

Florida State and Miami are booked for a 11:30 a.m., showdown in Tully Gym this morning. Central Florida takes on once-beaten North Carolina at the same time.

FSU, hiking its season record to 18-7, swept to straight set victories over South Florida, Auburn and Florida Southern and took a three-set victory from North Carolina.

With Cordelia Campbell and freshmen Julie Brown and Sue Usher leading the way, the Lady Seminoles over South Florida 15-8, 15-7, over Auburn 15-16, 15-10, over Florida Southern 15-8, 15-6 and over UNC 15-10, 10-15 and 15-12.

In other matches today, Miami Dade South will meet Memphis State and Tennessee will meet Florida Southern in a pair of matches at 10 a.m.

The winners will meet for fifth place at 1 p.m., and the two losers will play off for seventh place at the same time.

The losers of the FSU-UM and Central Florida-UNC matches will play for third place at 2:30 p.m.

The winners will play the championship match at 4 p.m.
