

FSU volleyball team wins

MEMPHIS — The Florida State women's volleyball team reeled off three straight match victories Friday to take the first round lead in the inaugural Metro Conference Volleyball Championship.

The Lady Seminoles will play three times again today in this round robin tournament in which the team with the most victories at the end of play today will be crowned the winner. Should two teams finish with identical marks after regular play, a title match will be played between them at 8:30 p.m.

FSU garnered victories Friday over Louisville (15-7, 15-9), Virginia Tech (13-15, 15-4, 15-2) and Memphis State (15-8, 15-9). Leading the way for the Seminoles were freshman Shannon Lages, who had 23 point-spikes in three games, and sophomore Alicia Cross, who had 21 point-spikes.
