

FSU spikers lead tournament

ORLANDO — The Florida State women's volleyball team is in first place after four matches in the University of Central Florida Invitational.

After dropping a match to Florida International (10-15, 9-15) to open play Friday, the Lady Seminoles stormed back to beat Miami (15-10, 15-7), host Central Florida (15-11, 15-10) and South Carolina-Spartanburg (15-2, 15-3).

FSU was led by freshmen Sally Summer and Shannon Lages, who reeled off 22 and 20 point-spikes, respectively. Sophomore Alicia Cross chipped in with 18 point-spikes.

The tournament continues through today. FSU's season record stands at 14-6.
