

# Lady 'Noles win twice but lose to Texas in volleyball

Florida State took a 15-13, 15-11, 15-6 quarterfinal victory over Minnesota, lost a five-game 12-15, 15-3, 5-15, 15-11, 15-12 semifinal match to number one seed Texas before defeating fifth-seeded Texas-Arlington 15-9, 13-15, 15-10 in the loser's bracket of the AIAW National Volleyball Championships at Tully Gym Friday.

Behind the strong play of Alicia Cross and Kayrn Palgut, the Lady Seminoles grabbed a two game lead in the match, led the fourth game 11-8 and came back from an 8-1 deficit in the fifth game to force ties at nine, 10 and 11 before losing 15-12.

The Longhorns, 5-6, also beat Utah State 15-8, 15-12, 10-15, 15-11 in the winner's bracket while Portland State won a 15-13, 17-15, 3-10 over Texas-Arlington and beat

Southwest Missouri State 2-15, 11-15, 15-8, 15-9, 15-9 in the semifinals.

In the consolation finals North Carolina beat Ohio State to claim 11th place and Pittsburgh ended its season with a ninth-place finish by beating California-Berkeley 15-12, 2-15, 16-14.

The winners advance to the next round of the loser's bracket and will play each other today, beginning at 10 a.m. with a match between Florida State and Utah State. The losers play in a consolation game at 12:30 p.m.

Texas plays Portland State in the winner's bracket final at 10 a.m.

The championship game is slated for 7 p.m.
