

FSU wins tournament

BATON ROUGE, La. — Florida State's Women's Volleyball team swept five matches to win the Second Annual Tiger Invitational over the weekend.

The Lady Seminoles won three times Saturday and twice Sunday to capture the crown for the second straight year. On Saturday they defeated Clemson 15-7, 15-0, 15-4, and then downed Rice 15-13, 15-9, 15-7. FSU won the day's final match over New Orleans 15-9, 15-5, 15-4.

Southern University was the next victim, falling 15-8, 15-4, 15-2 Sunday. In the finals, Florida State rallied to down host school LSU in a marathon, 13-15, 15-11, 8-15, 15-10, 15-8.

FSU placed three players on the all-tournament team: Julie Brown, Marie Sanders, and Carol Forsten. Forsten was selected as the tourney's Most Valuable Player.

The next contest for the Lady 'Noles will be in Pittsburgh Sept. 16, where they will play the Panthers, Penn State, and Louisville.
