

FSU leads volleyball tourney

The Florida State University volleyball team defeated its three opponents to take the first-day lead in the 14th annual Lady Seminole Invitational, being held at Tully Gym.

The Lady Seminoles, 13-2, beat Tennessee-Chattanooga 15-3, 15-3, 15-9; South Carolina 15-12, 15-8, 15-4 and closed the day by dropping Clemson 15-9, 15-7, 15-3.

North Carolina, which came back to beat South Florida and Tennessee-Chattanooga after losing its opening match to South Carolina, stood alone in second place with a 2-1 record. South Carolina and South Florida were tied for third at 1-1 while Clemson placed fifth at 1-2. Tennes-

see-Chattanooga was sixth at 0-3.

Final round action starts today at 10 a.m. with two games, including North Carolina vs. Clemson and South Florida vs. South Carolina. FSU will play two matches today, against South Florida at noon and North Carolina at 5 p.m.
