

Tired FSU volleyballers pull out a win

Florida State's volleyball team, ranked 15th in the nation, ran its record to 23-5 Tuesday night with a 15-17, 15-11, 15-7, 15-9 win over the Clemson Tigers in Tully Gym.

The win broke a two-match losing streak for FSU, which dropped contests to Top 10 teams San Diego State and Texas over the weekend.

Clemson fell to 11-26 on the year.

"I think what we had tonight was a case of a very tired team playing," FSU head coach Cecile Reynaud said. "We played in Houston on Sunday night and just got back to town Monday afternoon. Our timing was off a bit, but at least we kept our composure after losing the first game and came back to win the match."

FSU returns to action Nov. 11, competing in the North Carolina Invitational.
