

FSU women win season's 20th volleyball game

The Florida State Lady Seminoles' volleyball team won their 20th game of the season Tuesday night, defeating the University of Evansville 15-8, 15-4, 15-4.

Sherry Smith, Joan Morris and Karyn Palgut led the way for FSU, now 20-9, getting nine kills each. Lisa Smith added two to give the quartet 35 of the teams 40 kills. Florida State had a hitting percentage of .428 on the night.

Evansville, which struggled the entire night, barely hit one percent (.013). Laura Slab was the leading hitter for Evansville, getting five kills.
