

FSU wins in volleyball

HATTIESBURG — Taking advantage of several Southern Mississippi errors, the Florida State women's volleyball team breezed past the Lady Golden Eagles 15-1, 15-2 and 15-5 in Metro Conference action Sunday. It was the first Metro match for the Lady Seminoles, who improved their record to 8-6.

The Lady Seminoles enjoyed their finest offensive showing of the young season with a .400 attack percentage. Twanna Walker hit 71 percent of her shots with five kills and no errors. Julie Todd had five kills and no errors in 11 attempts, and added nine blocks on defense. Joan Morris had two service aces for the Lady Seminoles, who return home for matches against South Alabama today and South Florida on Wednesday. Both matches start at 7:30 p.m. in Tully Gym.
