

## Volleyball team's win streak continues

CINCINNATI — The Florida State Lady Seminole volleyball team won its 15th consecutive match defeating the Cincinnati Lady Bearcats in four games by scores of 15-8, 15-4, 8-15, 15-11 in the newly constructed Myrl Shoemaker Center on Saturday afternoon.

It was the first home loss for the Bearcats this season who drop to 14-7 on the season and 3-1 in Metro action. Florida State raises its record to 18-2 and 4-0 in conference play. The Lady Seminoles are tied for first in the conference with Memphis State, also undefeated in Metro play.

After winning the first two games, Cincinnati altered its offensive attack to work around FSU's blocking attack, which produced better than 30 total blocks for the second night in a row. Gabrielle Reece led the Lady Seminoles with 11 total blocks and Vicki Zinkil has seven blocks.
