

Lady Seminole volleyball team extends win streak to 16

WEST LAFAYETTE, Ind. — The Florida State Lady Seminole volleyball team completed a three-match road sweep, defeating the Purdue Boilermakers 15-12, 15-13, 15-13 Sunday.

It was the 16th consecutive victory for the Lady Seminoles, who raise their record to 19-2 on the season. Purdue dropped its ninth straight match and fell to 5-12.

FSU rallied in each game of the match, coming back from a 13-12 deficit in game three. Florida State was down 10-4 in the second game.

The match featured a shootout of kill leaders from each team between FSU's Maggie Philgence and Purdue's Debbie McDonald. Philgence took the showdown 20-15.

Florida State's next action will be at home Friday when the Lady Seminoles meet Alabama-Birmingham at 3 p.m., and South Florida at 7 p.m. in Tully Gym.
