Lady 'Noles eliminated from NCAA tourney

The Florida State volleyball team falls with a first-round loss to Northern Illinois.

For the second straight season, Florida State went out quickly.

The Lady Seminoles lost in four games, 15-10, 11-15, 10-15, 12-15, to Northern Illinois in the first round of the NCAA volleyball tournament on Friday at Louisville Gardens. Last season, FSU lost to South Florida in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Northern Illinois advanced to today's second round against the winner of Friday night's match between Louisville and American.

FSU completed its season at 25-11. "Northern Illinois did an outstanding job of putting together a game plan to beat us tonight," said FSU coach Cecile Reynaud. "Their outside hitters hit the ball very hard.

"We just didn't show up very sharp tonight. It is extremely disappointing. This year we felt that we had a good draw. With our five seniors, this team could have gone farther."

Senior Holly Schneider closed out her career with a double-double, posting 16 kills and 11 digs in the match, which lasted 2½ hours. Jennifer Werrick also had a double-double with 13 kills and 12 digs.

Senior LaToya Washington ended the night with 12 kills and seven blocks. Susan Hawks totaled nine kills and a team-leading eight blocks. Setter Fiona Bolten notched 58 assists.

"We could never pick up the momentum and get out of the deficit that we put ourselves in," Schneider said.

Down 14-7 in the third game, FSU fought off three NIU game-points and closed to within four, but a block from Huskie junior Christy Mikesell put the game away for Northern Illinois and put FSU behind two games to one.

Three kills from senior outside hitter Holly Schneider and a strong block from junior middle hitter Aisha Thornton helped boost the Lady Seminoles to a 7-2 lead in game four.

But FSU lost the momentum once again as the Huskies scored 11 of the next 13 points to take a 13-9 edge. After an NIU error gave FSU its 10th point, a Christy Mikesell kill put Northern Illinois within one point of the match.

Florida State fought off a pair of match points and picked up two points of its own, but Northern Illinois finished off the Lady Seminoles with a kill off an FSU block to win the match.

FSU finished the season with team records in total kills and assists in one season and their first Atlantic Coast Conference championship.
