

FSU volleyball downs Georgia Tech: Norisha Campbell had 22 kills, and Erica Bunch had 20 kills and 10 digs as Florida State defeated Georgia Tech 15-11, 15-5, 9-15, 15-10 in ACC volleyball action. FSU (20-10, 8-7) won 20 matches for the first time since going 25-11 in 1998. It was also FSU's fourth ACC victory in five matches. Jennifer Werrick added 15 kills and 11 digs for FSU, which also had 64 assists and 15 digs from Jennifer Anderson. Georgia Tech (22-6, 12-3) had 18 kills and 13 digs from Teryl Townsend. FSU closes its regular-season schedule at 6 p.m. today at Clemson.

Lady Jackets upset 3-1 by Seminoles

N Junior middle blocker Norisha Campbell had a match-high 22 kills and a .500 hitting percentage on Friday as Florida State's volleyball squad upset Georgia Tech 3-1 (15-11, 15-5, 9-15, 15-10) at O'Keefe Gymnasium.

The Seminoles (20-10, 8-7 ACC) capitalized on eight kills by Campbell in the first game before hitting for a .333 percentage in the second game, opening up a 2-0 lead in the match.

After Georgia Tech (22-6, 12-3 ACC) rallied to capture Game 3, Florida State held off a late fourth-game rally by the Jackets to seal the victory.

Junior outside hitter Eida Mabry had 21 kills for the Jackets.
