CROSS COUNTRY

Young and inexperienced. That's the best way to describe Florida State's men's and women's cross country squads as they enter the 1991 season.

With few familiar faces on the men's side, and returnees with little experience among Lady Seminoles, FSU begins its Era in the Atlantic Coast Conference—a traditionally strong conference in distance events.

Third-year head coach Sue Addison hopes her runners can mature in time

for their first ACC Championship meet in November.

"Most of these schools track programs are built around distance squads," Addison said. "It is a strong conference in track and cross country, with teams that do well at the district and national meets."

The Lady Seminoles have five returnees, but only senior Angela Harris has more than one year of experience. Four different Lady Seminoles led FSU in its six meets in 1990, but only one returns. With just seven runners, the women must stay injury free to compete.

Addison lost tested runners Tracey Howze, Kerry Moloughney and Karla Severs from last years squad. Both Howze and Moloughney transferred and Severs, a two-year letterwinner, will most likely redshirt while recovering from an injury.

Harris, two-time all-Metro Conference in cross country, placed 15th in the conference meet

a year ago and led the Lady Seminoles on three occasions. She qualified for both the 1990 indoor and outdoor nationals in the 800-meters.

Backing up Harris will be sophomores Lisa Beck, Stacey Bowrosen and Tracey Pepoon. According to Addison, Beck looks to be the early leader after a good summer of training.

Addison is also counting on contributions from freshman Shawn Clark and sophomore Kim Stephens—the former Kim Mann—who has two years of track experience under her belt.

"We have to stay healthy with just seven girls," Addison said. "Angela's experience should help and we really need Stacey (Bowrosen) and Lisa (Beck) to run consistently. "

Seven men return from last years squad, but FSU must replace its top two performers from 1990. Gone are Jason Frank, who led the Seminoles in the last five meets and placed third in the Metro, and Matthew Dobson.

"We lost our top returning runner and a potential all-conference," Addison said of Frank, who transferred to South Florida.

To fill those shoes, Addison is counting on sophomore Michael Hampton, who ran in just three meets as a freshman. Philip Healy, who also participated in just three meets as a freshmen, is coming off a very good European season and will challenge Hampton for the top spot.

Junior College transfer Steve Wilcox and Trey Culbertson, a transfer from the Air Force Academy, will vie for top five positions. Three-year letterman Chris Keeney should also contend.

Addison hopes to find improvement and help from lettermen Rob Circelli, Jason Kaiser, and John Winkler.

"We should have a closer knit group of runners, but I don't know how far up they will be," said Addison. "We hope to be competitive in the conference and do well at the Florida Intercollegiate to improve our state standings.

"The ACC is extremely strong in distance events. We have our work cut out for us."



HEAD COACH SUE ADDISON

CROSS COUNTRY

Sue Addison enters her third season as a member of the Seminole track and field coaching staff. A veteran runner and coach, she handles the middle distance and distance runners in the spring and will direct all

aspects of the cross country program in the fall.

Addison joined the staff two years ago, and although a newcomer to Tallahassee, she is not new to track and field. A three-time All-American at Michigan State and a member of six U.S.A. National Track teams, she was ranked the number one miler of 1986 for the U.S. while representing Reebok as an international track athlete. In addition, she was the national champion in the 800 meters (2:03) her junior year at Michigan State and in 1986 posted the nation's best time in the mile run (4:23), which stands as the third fastest time ever.

Addison's coaching experience includes a stint as head women's track & cross country coach at Brown University during the 1981-82 season and assistant track and field coach at the University of Colorado from 1985-1988. During her tenure at Colorado, she developed the Buffaloes' cross country team into one of the strongest in the Big Eight Conference. This included coaching two All-Americans and four Big Eight Champions, one being Mike Macinko, and 800 meter runner who represented the United States in the World Cup.

Completing her bachelor's degree in Physical Education in 1978 and her master's in Athletic Administration in 1981, both from Michigan State, Addison is proving to be a great asset to the Florida State Seminoles. In her first year at Florida State all the middle distance and distance runners set personal bests under her quidance.

Addison and her husband, Ron, have been married for nine years and have one daughter, Rebecca.





ASSISTANT COACH MIKE CURCIO



Mike Curcio begins his fourth season with the

Seminole Track and Field Coaching staff, working closely with cross country coach Sue Addison in the development of all distance runners at Florida State.

A four-year letterwinner at Appalachian State, Curcio participated on both the track and cross country squads. After graduating in 1987 with a degree in Physical Education, Curcio returned to his native New York and headed the track program at St. John the Baptist High School. In that position he was responsible for all aspects of the track program for one of the largest Catholic schools in the state.

Curcio will serve as meet coordinator for FSU's home meets. Earlier this year, Curcio directed the World Cross Country Trials and the TAC Junior International Track Meet, both held in Tallahassee.

Curcio, 26, is currently working on a master's degree in Athletic Administration at Florida State.

year...a high school All-American and two-time outdoor state 1600 meter champion and indoor two-mile champion.

Competed in the last three cross country meets after recovering from a stress fracture...expected to run in the top five...off a very good summer season where he ran in Europe...placed twentieth in the Metro Championships...represented N. Ireland in the World Jr. Cross Country Championships...top-ranked 1500 meter Jr.

(under 20) in the United Kingdom in 1989...Irish schools cross country champion in 1988.



JASON KAISER

A returning letterman...looks to contend with the top runners...an all-county, district, and regional champion in high school...second team all-state at Sanford Seminole H.S.



CHRIS KEENEY

Has lettered the past three years...will battle it out for a top five position...leadership and experience will help strengthen the team...placed 16th at the Metro Cross Country Championships in 1989...an all-state performer at Punahov High School in Hawaii...state runner-up in the mile as a senior.



LISA BECK

Should be among FSU's top three runners in 1991...returns in top shape after running strong during the summer...amoung the top five Lady Seminoles in all six meets as a freshman in 1990...placed fourth overall in the FSU-Georgia Tech dual meet with a season best 19:07...Florida 2A state champion in both the mile and two-

mile runs out of Cardinal Newman H.S.



STACEY BOWROSEN

Will be relied upon as a consistent top three performer for the Lady Seminoles...a healthier, more confident runner in 1991 after battling a severe ankle injury as a freshman...placed tenth overall at the Barnett Bank Invitational with a season best 19:07...all-area, county, and state in cross county and track at Father Lopez H.S.

SHAWN CLARK

Should make a substantial contribution during her freshman season...will be relied upon early in the season due to Lady Seminoles lack of depth...ran cross country at Cleveland Heights H.S.



ANGELA HARRIS

The Lady Seminoles top returnee after leading FSU in three of six meets in 1990...two-time all-Metro Conference in cross country...placed second overall in the Georgia Tech dual meet with a season best time of 18:44...1991 NCAA Indoor and Outdoor qualifier and conference champion in the 800-meters...1990 Indoor All-

American in the 3,200-meter relay...an all-state performer in cross country and track at Orange Park H.S.



TRACEY PEPOON

Expected to vie for a top spot when healthy...recovering from a stress-fracture and is hoping to be ready by mid-October...all-state and three-time cross country MVP at Ft. Walton Beach H.S.



KIM STEPHENS

Running cross country for the first time after two years of track experience...a versatile track performer who has experience in the 800 meters...1989 state heptathalon champion at John I. Leonard H.S.
