

1992 MEN'S & WOMEN'S OUTLOOK

Head Coach Sue Addison answers questions about her 1992 team:

How would you describe this year's squad?

"This women's team may be the best we've had at FSU the past three or four years. The 11 girls are all experienced and strong athletes."

"The men's squad will be thinner than years past. However, this team will use maturity and experience to make up for a lack of athletes."

What do you expect of the team this year?

"I expect continued improvement from the women. They ran well at the ACC meet last year and return all but one of the scorers."

"The men are better prepared for the upcoming season than last year's team. Although the depth is questionable, we are hoping for a fifth or sixth place finish at the ACC meet."

How about the ACC?

"The women could run great this year and still finish in the bottom half of the conference. We are aiming for a third or fourth place finish in this distance-oriented conference."

"The men's team is looking to improve on a sub-par performance at the 1991 ACC meet. They now know what to expect of the conference meet, and more importantly, how to prepare for it."





Who should be the top performers and what can we expect from them?

"There are no stars or standouts on the women's squad. What we have is a group of strong, consistent runners that will run close to one another."

"Mike Hampton and Trey Culbertson will vie for the top spot. Mike has the early edge, but Trey could end the season number one. Steve Wilcox could also factor into that top spot."

Any key losses from the previous year?

"We lost Angela Harris, who finished 1991 as our top runner. We have four capable athletes in Lisa Beck, Stacey Bowrosen, Holly Higgins and Karla Severs, that could replace her."

"Philip Healey returned to Ireland this year. That is our only men's key loss."

Any new recruits ready to make an impact?

"Holly Higgins, a transfer-student from UNC-Charlotte, brings even more experience to the squad. A couple of freshman, Erin Wilder and Monica Pfeifer, might make a difference. Jennifer Mendelson sat out last year as a redshirt. She looks stronger than ever."

HEAD COACH

SUE ADDISON

Sue Addison enters her fourth season as a member of the Seminole track and field coaching staff. A veteran runner and coach, she handles the middle distance and distance runners in the spring and will direct all aspects of the cross country program in the fall.


Addison joined the staff three years ago, and although was a newcomer to Tallahassee, she was not new to track and field. A three-time All-American at Michigan State and a member of six U.S.A. National Track teams, she was ranked the number one miler of 1986 for the U.S. while representing Reebok as an international track athlete. In addition, she was the national champion in the 800 meters (2:03) her junior year at Michigan State and in 1986 posted the nation's best time in the mile run (4:23), which now stands as the third fastest time ever.

Addison's coaching experience includes a stint as head women's track and cross country coach at Brown University during the 1981-82 season and assistant track and field coach at the University of Colorado from 1985-88. During her tenure at Colorado, she developed the Buffalo's cross country team into a Big Eight Conference power. She coached two All-Americans and four Big Eight Champions, while at Colorado.

Completing her bachelor's degree in Physical Education in 1978 and her master's in Athletic Administration in 1981, both from Michigan State, Addison has proved to be a great asset to the Florida State Seminoles. In her first year at Florida State all the middle distance and distance runners set personal bests under her guidance and continue to improve through the years.


Mike Hampton-Should be a top performer this season...trained well this summer and has matured over the past year...expected to

third place finish at the Florida State Invitational.

Lisa Beck - A very consistent performer...always finishes in the top three on the squad...one of the more experienced runners on this year's team...also has 5,000 meter experience on the track...ran a personal best 18:31 in helping team to a fifth place

finish at the conference meet...a former high school state champion in both the mile and two-mile runs.



Stacey Bowrosen - Team's top question mark entering the fall season...has been a top individual but chronic knee problems have slowed her down...hopes to be in peak form by the ACC meet...one of the top performers on squad last season...finished second in

the Georgia Tech, North Florida dual meet; and sixth at the Barnett Bank Invitational where she ran a season best 18:35...an All-County and All-State selection in high school.



Holly Higgins - Transfer student from UNC-Charlotte that will vie for the top three spots... adds a new demension to the team...possesses an aggressive attitude...seems to attack the workouts.



Tracey Pepoon - Should contend for top individual honors this season...returns much stronger than previous seasons... strong track athlete in the 5,000 and 10,000 meters that carries over to cross-country... ran a season best 18:57 at the confer-

ence meet...hopes to improve on that mark at this year's ACC meet...a former high school All-State athlete.



Karla Severs Team Captain expected to provide leadership...trained hard this summer and is ready to vie for top team honors...Sidelined

last season with a foot injury...a 1990 letter winner... took top team honors at the Georgia State Invitational that year...highly successful track athlete and an Indoor All-American in1990...Florida state Cross Country runner-up and two-time 880 yard champ in high school.



Kerry White Will help contribute this year while trying to adjust to cross-country...will run her first cross-country meet ever when FSU travels

to Atlanta for the Georgia State Invitational...a nationally ranked track athlete last year in high school.. finished third in the 800 meters at the Golden West Invitational this past spring...Indiana State Champion that was also awarded the 1992 Indiana Mental Attitude Award.
