




Head coach Nicky Goetze with Don Veller at the dedication of the Seminoles' golf facility in 2001.




Dave Middleton (l) and Don Veller at the opening of the Seminole golf facility bearing their names.

One wing of the clubhouse is dedicated to the Seminole men's and women's teams and provides private locker rooms, coach's offices and meeting rooms as well as a player's lounge where student-athletes can study between classes and practices. The rich histories of Florida State's golf programs are on display for aspiring collegiate golfers to admire. A high-Tech training range with multiple tees and target areas have been built to enable Seminole players to practice a broad range of shots.

The impressive clubhouse also houses Florida State's Professional Golf Management Program, a PGA-certified academic program within the College of Business.

The new clubhouse, practice range and PGM program are the jewels of the golf programs at Florida State University.


