

Seminole Golf Course

The Seminole Golf Course is located approximately two miles west of the university campus. The course was designed by William W. Amick. The first nine holes were completed in 1963 and the additional ninewere finished in 1968.

The course measures 7,033 yards from the championship tees, and is considered an excellent test of golf. The greens, **TIFTON 328 (bermuda)** are of medium size, approximately 6,200 square feet each. The course rating is 72.0.

The course and practice facilities are considered among the best in the country. The Seminole Golf Course is run and operated by *Club Consultation* and *Management*, a private golf course management firm. There have been many improvements made and within the next five years, it should prove to be one of the finest courses in the area.

Coach Debbie Miles-Dillman

Debbie Miles-Dillman, the assistant coach of Florida State University's men's and women's golf teams, entered her seventh year in that position in 1990-

91. Miles-Dillman is in charge of many administrative duties and travels with the women's team.

Miles-Dillman was coached by Verlyn Giles as a Lady Seminole golfer herself, on the team that won the AIAW National Championship in 1981. She also played a major role in the high national ranking of the 1979-80 team.


Miles-Dillman was an undergraduate student at FSU from 1979-82 and worked at the Seminole Golf Course in various capacities. The experience gave her useful exposure to the many complications and incidents that can arise when handling a golf course. In working with the Seminole teams, Miles-Dillman uses much of the knowledge she gained from her

work both on and off the golf course.

During the summer months, Miles-Dillman works with different junior and ladies golf organizations in nearby Quincy and Monticello, where her excellent reputation as a coach precedes her. Her knowledge of the sport of golf in the areas of management, competition regulations and rules, and entertainment has grown from the various work and competitive experiences she has had.

A native of Davison, Mich., Miles-Dillman grew up around golf. Her parents were heavily involved in country club management. During her high school career, Miles-Dillman was a three-time Flint Junior Golf Champion, which was named the number one golf program in the country. She was the captain of her high school team for four years and was twice a runner-up at the Michigan State Championship, shooting a tournament record and winning the regional title her senior year.

Miles-Dillman was married this past September 8 to Fred Dillman of Tallahassee.

Junior Emma Rundle

This year, the Lady Seminole golf team is planning on a solid season. After a learning and gaining experience in 1989-90, the team is looking to improve its national standing with a highly-talented, but young, group this year. The eldest members, juniors Emma Rundle and Mary Lee Cobick, are expected to provide a consistent duo who will lead the Lady Seminoles on the golf course over the next two years.

Supporting Rundle and Cobick are a talented throng of golfers. Erica Firnhaber, a sophomore who sat out last year after transferring from Southern Illinois, is a prospective number one or two golfer. Marie-Josee' Rouleau, also coming into the golf world after a year of waiting for eligibility, reinforces the team with a back-

ground of winning tournament championships. Maria Castellucci, a freshman signee whose signing attracted attention to the FSU golf program, is a nationally ranked golfer, a top candidate for the AJGA Player of the Year, and is expected to be an important asset to the Lady Seminole team.

Three more golfers, Kelly Pittman, Kathleen Garrahan, and Carrie Wallace, all complement the team and will contribute with constant improvement. Waiting out a redshirt freshman season is Tiffany Faucette. She has the ability to become a dominating force on the team over the next few years and is presently working on perfecting those abilities with the assistance of coaches Giles and Miles-Dillman.

Giles is enthusiastic about the 1990-91 team.

"We are capable of winning any tournament we enter," Giles said. "This is the best team without seniors since our 1981 championship team. If we qualify for the nationals, we could be the Cinderella team of the year."

And Miles-Dillman, who spends much of her time working with the women's team agrees, and likes the competitive attitude of the squad.

"They are a relatively young, but very competitive group," Miles-Dillman said. "They should start coming into their own this year. They play with a lot of pride and intensity, which are two key ingredients to a winning season."

FSU Wins 1981 National Championship

Florida State won its fourth and most important tournament championship of 1981 at the AIAW National Championship in Athens, Ga. By rallying on the back nine on the final day of the tournament, the Lady Seminoles defeated the homestanding Lady Bulldogs of Georgia.

After the third round, FSU led by one stroke over host Georgia. A stumble on the front nine of the final round pushed the Tribe back two shots back. Florida State, however, came back on the final nine and when four of the five FSU players birdied the 17th hole, Florida State was on its way to finishing three shots ahead of Georgia.

Lisa Young was FSU's top finisher in third place and Barb Bunkowsky birdied the last five holes to finish in a tie for 14th.

Florida State in the NCAA Championships

The Florida State Seminoles participated in the 1990 NCAA Championships in Tarpon Springs, Florida and came away with one of the best finishes in school history. The Seminoles placed eighth last year with a four-day total of 1169, one stroke behind the seventh place finishers, North Carolina. Senior Andy Purnell tiedfor sixth place and was the highest finisher for Florida State. Other FSU finishers included: Roger Winchester (tied 17th), Dustin Phillips (tied 61st), Christian Williams (tied 87th), and John Tighe (tied 126th).

Florida State's best-ever finish was in 1987 at the Scarlet Golf Course in Columbus, Ohio. The Seminoles placed seventh that year, led by All-American Nolan Henke who tied for second, six shots behind the leader. The final four day score of the Seminoles was 1191, four strokes behind sixth-place Arkansas.
