- The most wins in the history of the program (14)
- · Five wins over ranked teams:
 - 3-2 over No. 6 Florida
 - 4-1 over No. 7 Texas A&M
 - 2-0 over No. 20 Wake Forest
 - 3-2 over No. 2 North Carolina
 - 2-1 over No. 11 Florida (NCAA)
 - *rankings at the time of the game
- First team to ever defeat the last two National Champions in one season (UF and UNC)
- First trip to the NCAA Tournament and first-ever Sweet 16
- Southeast Region and Runner-Up National Coach of the Year (Patrick Baker)
- · Southeast Region Freshman of the Year (Emma Breland)
- First-ever All-America selection (Emma Breland)
- First-ever All-ACC first team selection (Emma Breland)
- Most home wins in a season (9)
- The two largest home crowds in the history of the program
 - 1,582 in a 3-2 win over North Carolina
 - 1,282 in a 3-2 win over Florida
- First-ever victory against six different schools
- Perfect 8-0 record against teams from Florida
- · Longest winning streak (5) and unbeaten streak (7) in FSU history
