### **2009 TRACK:**

**OUTDOOR** 

- Named first Seminole in FSU history to win both the long and triple jump titles at the NCAA Outdoor Championships in the same season and the second student-athlete to do so in NCAA history.
- Jumped 6.54m/21-5.50 in a four-way tie breaker to win first place in the long jump at the 2009 NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Set a new personal record in the long jump at the NCAA Regional Meet with an impressive 6.66m/21-10.25 leap that was the second best performance in the nation and FSU's top long jump in history.
- Named the ACC Women's Field Performer of the Year for the second-consecutive season after she earned first place in the long jump of 21-06.75 and took another gold medal in the triple jump with 44-08.75 at the ACC Outdoor Meet.
- Earned All-ACC honors in both the long and triple jump.

### **INDOOR**

- $\bullet$  FSU's only NCAA Champion at the NCAA Indoor Championships. Won the gold medal in the triple jump with a mark of 13.81m/45-3.75.
- Dominated the triple jump at the ACC Outdoor Championships with a mark of 45-03.00/13.79m to take home the gold medal and reset the ACC meet record.
- Leaped to a first place finish, reset the school record and made the NCAA automatic mark with 14.03m/46-00.50 in the triple jump at the Virginia Tech Hokie Invitational.
- Notched a silver medal and set a new personal record in the long jump of 21-02.75/6.47m at the ACC Indoor Championships.
