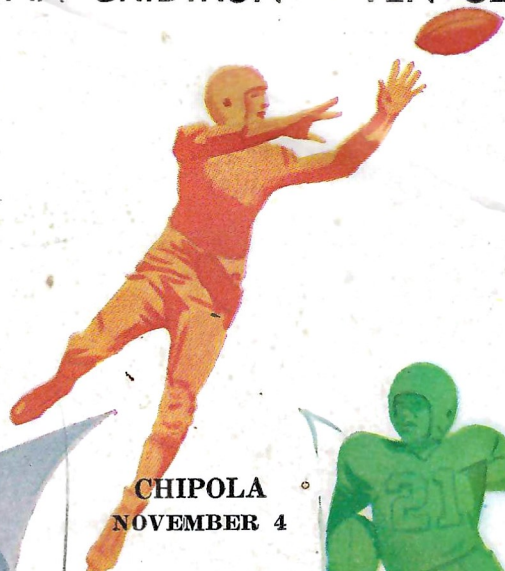

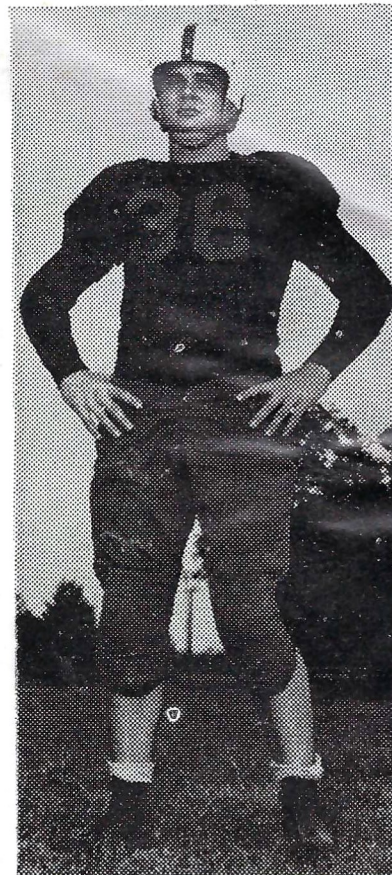

## Troy Red Wave vs Florida State Seminoles

Troy State's opponent tonight should be the most powerful team the Wave has met to date. The husky Florida eleven will be after its 17th triumph out of 19 starts.

Losing only two games in the last two years, FSU will display many new faces tonight in opening their eight game schedule. The invaders copped the Dixie Conference Championship in 1948 and 1949. January 2, FSU battered Woffard 19-6 a team that shelled Auburn last Friday 19-14.

The Seminoles have only 12 lettermen returning. Despite this fact Coach Don Veller is expecting another power-packed machine. Freshmen and transfer students with experience from the Mid-west are expected to give FSU another championship eleven.

Transfer players from Indiana University, Florida U., West Point and Tampa will give the Seminoles another hard running backfield. Nine of these transfer backs coupled with holdovers from last year will give FSU just as smooth a running backfield as the one that downed the Wave 20-0 last year.

In the Seminole line the tackles and center probably are the weakest spots. However transfer players again should bring these positions back to par with the 1949 machine. The Seminole starting lineup will be just as strong as last year. At tackle and center newcomers will have to develop.

For the first time this year Troy will be the decided underdog, despite the fact it is FSU's opening game and the third for the Wave.

Florida State has thoroughly scouted the Wave. FSU saw Troy against Southeastern and last week coaches took in the Stetson contest.

In three previous meetings between the two machines Troy has won one while FSU has copped two battles.

Despite two straight defeats the Red Wave has shown a strong offensive and defensive club. Tough breaks in both contests have caused a score difference that statistics failed to prove. Fumbles deep in their own territory have resulted in opponents scoring.

FSU has an enrollment of 6,000. Colors are Garnet and Gold. Troy State's enrollment is slightly less than 1,000. Colors are Crimson and Black. FSU is a member of the Dixie Conference while Troy is a member of the S. I. A. A.
