The Flying Circus

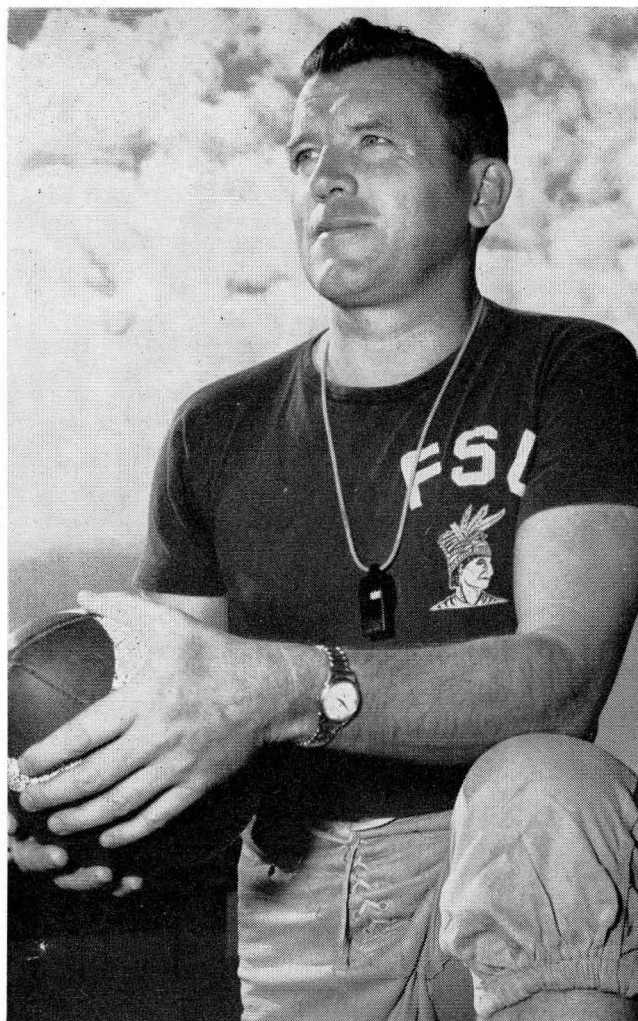
The famed Flying Circus from Florida State University will stage a spectacular show during halftime today. The title of the show is "Scenes from the Big Top."

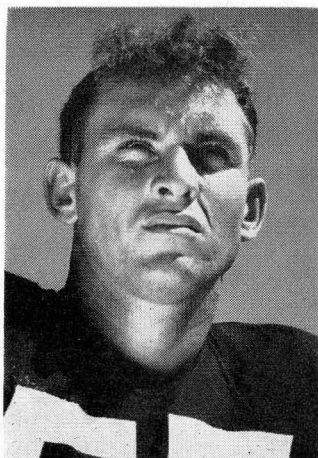

The acts in the halftime show today are only a portion of the renowned Flying Circus, which tours throughout the Southeast each season.

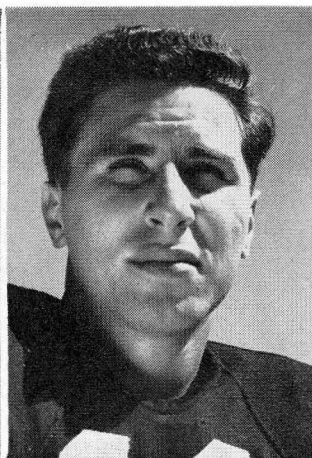
This same show has been presented at halftime in the Orange Bowl in Miami. Fans at the game today are in for a real treat.



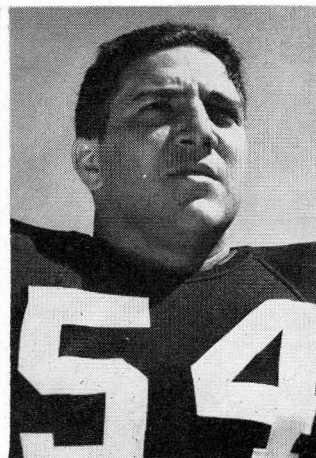

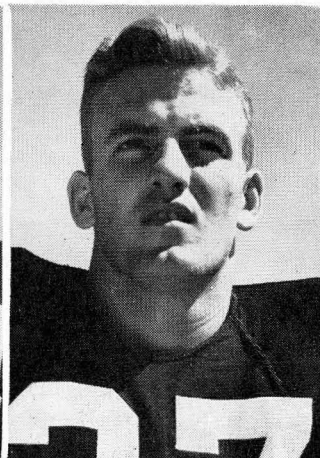



The Game Today

“Home cooking” and Cliff Hare Stadium never tasted or looked better for a road-weary group of Auburn football players. Three straight lickings in the neighbors’ backyard have converted many to home lovers. Even the nation’s worst pressbox (by national votes) looks like the Waldorf Astoria.

Auburn’s squadron of X’s and Y’s don’t have to hang their heads in shame over losses to Florida, Kentucky, and Georgia Tech. They were beaten but not in a shameful manner. True, a loss is a loss, but these three were by one touchdown in the neighbors’ backyards. As one Auburn man said after the fine showing in Atlanta, “I was proud of my team Saturday. The scoreboard showed we lost but in my heart I know that we really won.”

Today we have the upsurging Seminoles of Florida State University in our backyard with a potent football machine and a colorful group of college students forming the “Flying High” Circus.

The biggest end in America is with this freshman- and sophomore-studded group—Tom Feamster of Warwick, Va., weighing 249 and standing six feet, seven inches.

Coach Tom Nugent has come a long way in a short time with a young team. After losses to Georgia and Abilene Christian, his team has scored victories over Louisville, 47-6; Villanova, 52-13, and North Carolina State, 13-7. A most surprising factor has been their amazing passing attack which has contributed eight touchdowns in the last three games.

Auburn’s attack this fall might be called a well-balanced offense. Joe Childress and Dave Middleton, both of the Y team, have gained

over 214 yards rushing while Fob James has added 142 for the X team. Overall team rushing is now 217.3 yards per game. The passing average is 83.0 yards. Together, Auburn is averaging 300.3 yards per game to the opponents’ 246.3.

Probably one of the most talked about Plainsmen this season is Guard Bob Scarbrough, 205-pound Junior from Troy. Handsome Robert has been the kingpin of the line and played himself a great game Saturday in Atlanta. All-Star honors might be a year away but they are definitely in his plans.

F.S.U. has stepped out in the world in more ways than one. Their 38-man traveling squad lists only 13 Florida boys. The starting team lists four Florida boys—Lee Corso, John Griner, Bob Barber, and Bob Crenshaw.

Names not too common on the Plains at the present like Al Makowiecki, Al Pacifico, Vic Prinzi, Mercury Paskalakis, Patrick Versprille, Ray Staab, and Ronnie Schomburger might be very well-known before the afternoon is over.

Auburn’s X and Y lineup will probably see no radical changes although James has been working with both teams during the past week at lefthalf. Another name that might bob up in either lineup is tackle Jim Warren, a strong-armed Sophomore who saw his first action against Tech.

Starting with today’s game, Auburn gets only one mile out of the state for the remaining six games. This one-mile jaunt is into Columbus, Ga., on November 13 against Georgia. The remaining schedule is Tulane in Mobile; Miami in Birmingham; Georgia; Clemson here for Homecoming, and Alabama in Birmingham for the finale.
