

FSU Announces Court Slate; To Open Drills

In conjunction with the release of Florida State University's 18-game tentative basketball schedule Donald Loucks, head court coach for the garnet and gold hoopsters today announced that a series of "screening out" practice sessions will get underway Mon Nov 3 at the FSU gym.

Loucks, who guided the US military academy plebes to better than 40 victories in 45 starts during the seasons of 1943, '44 and '45 expects approximately 150 court candidates to report before the season opens.

Loucks indicated that he planned to work the initial groups in compact workouts of 12-15 courtmen.

The Florida State slate, which pits the garnet and gold hoopsters against such strong teams within the state as the Stetson Hatters and Southern college Moes, will open December 10 when Spring Hill, Ala. invades the West campus gym.

The slate, which runs through the last of February, includes nine home appearances for the FSU hoopsters.
