

Central Downs FSU 62-50 on Foul Shots

FAYETTE, Mo.—A Central college cage team that was deadly accurate from the free throw line, snapped Florida State University's four-game winning streak here last night when they scored a 62-50 victory over the Seminoles in the Florida five's first stop on a three-game invasion of Missouri.

The Seminoles, who had won their first four games at home before embarking on their holiday tour, move over to Springfield tonight to meet Drury college in the second game of the road tour.

Hit 34 of 34

Coach Bud Kennedy's Indians outscored Central from the field last night 34-32 but couldn't begin to match the Missouri combine in the foul shooting department. Central caged 30 free throws out of 34 attempts to highlight a rough and tumble tilt that saw a total of 59 personal fouls called on the two teams.

Four players fouled out of the fray, FSU lost Lee Benjamin, Tom McLaughlin and Dick Kendall, and Central lost their big center, Christian, via the foul route.

In addition to the three Seminoles who drew the limit of personal fouls, FSU lost Dick Trobaugh when the swift forward suffered an ankle injury.

Kendall Tops FSU

Dean Ehlers, sharpshooting guard, paced Central's attack with 18 points compiled on five field goals and a half dozen foul shots. Christian had 13 points for the winners, and Young dropped in seven free throws without a miss.

Dick Kendall paced the Seminole scoring with 11 points, and combined with Trobaugh as the outstanding floor men in the defeat.
