

Southern Beats FSU 59-48 To Sweep Two-Game Series

LAKE LAND, Jan 14, (AP)

The Florida Southern Moccasins won their second straight basketball victory over the Florida State Seminoles in a dull game here tonight, 59-48.

The Seminoles, playing their third game in as many nights, were off their pace and showed the effects of the two preceding contests. Southern took the lead from the beginning and was ahead, 22-18, at the half.

The Southern five increased its advantage after the intermission, running it to 59-36 when the two minute rule went into effect. Florida State got control of the ball and added 12 points to its total before the final whistle.

Larry Dickson, FSU forward, was the game's high scorer with 15 points. Gene Robbins, FSC center, led the Southern players with 14.

The win was Florida Southern's seventh in nine starts. For Florida State, the season record was six losses and four victories.
