The sharp-eyed Seminoles, continuing their unbeaten ways in four straight games, snatched a 66 to 44 win from Howard College in a Dixie Conference scrap Friday night in the West Campus gym.

The Seminoles, playing a slightly slower brand of ball than they did in their wild over-time 76 to 68 win over Connecticut State the night before, got off to a dragging start as the Bulldogs took 10-9 lead after the two teams had traded buckets through the early minutes.

Captain Dick Trobaugh dropped in a two-pointer, putting the Indians back in the lead where they remained for the rest of the game. At half time Florida State held a 27 to 18 margin and from that time on, the Bulldogs could never get within seven points of the Seminoles, although they didn't get much farther away.

WHITMER HIGH

High point man for FSU was Bob Whitmer, lanky 6-2 forward from South Bend, who pocketed four shots from the field and missed only one free throw out of seven for a 14-point total.

Close on Whitmer's heels was Bud Marsee with five field goals and two gift shots for 12, while Bob Hartman followed with 11 points. Coming in late in the game, Larry Dickson lost no time popping in four field shots and a couple of free chances for 10 points.

Tall Tom McLaughlin, who held a 19-point high the night before, was limited to five against the Bulldogs.

Pacing his team with 14 points was Morris Jacobs, a slim six footer with a deadly eye, who sunk five field shots and four free tosses. Next in the scoring honors was Harold Parks, Howard captain, with 11 points.
