## Parris Island Cops 78-46 Cage Victory

PARRIS ISLAND, S. C.—Parris Island's defending national Marine champions stopped Florida State University in the Seminoles' basketball season opener here last night, rolling up a 78-46 victory.

The Florida quintet, playing without the services of Captain Bob Whitmer, was pretty well held in check by the smooth Marine cagers as Parris Island pulled steadily away to win by a 32-point margin.

The only Seminole able to hit the hoops with any success, was the veteran Tom McLaughlin, who paced FSU's scoring with 13 points.
