

BEAT MOCS, 79-77

Coach Bud Kennedy's surging Seminoles came from behind in the second half last night to rack up their seventh win of the season in a free-scoring duel with the Southern College Mocs.

Behind 37-35 at the halftime, FSU gained a 58-56 lead at the three-quarter mark and protected that two-point margin grimly through the final period.

Big Jerry Westhafer sizzled for the second successive game, tossing in 28 points for a total of 57 in games against Stetson and the Mocs.

Southern's Fred Lapper was high for the night, however, with 30 points. Seminole center Gary

Wold threw a blanket around Bill Leach, the Mocs' 300-point plus center, holding him to just two field goals and a pair of free throws.
