## Florida State Is Upset 79-54 By State Bucs

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn., Dec. 3.— P—East Tennessee State's wellcoordinated basketball team upset favored Florida State University, 79 to 54, here tonight to chalk up its third straight victory.

Five Buccaneers hit in the double figures, and the Bucs presented the best team play yet this season.

Center Herb Edmonds led the scoring with 14 points, followed by Herb Weaver, Jim Fleenor and Ferrell Bowman who gathered 12 each and Jerry Wilhoit who hooped 10.

The speedy Bucs out-ran the Seminoles all the way, with Bowman's sparkling floor play highlighting the ETSC offensive.

The former all-state at Science Hill High School stole the ball from the visitors on several occasions, and otherwise upset the Florida State defense and offense.

The game was close in the early stages, with ties at 2-2, 4-4, 6-6, 8-8, and 10-10 before East Tennessee started pulling away.

Halfway through the first half, however, the Bucs led by five points and then steadily increased their margin to 15 points at 38-23 by intermission.
