CHARLESTON, S. C.—The Citadel threw up 86 shots from the floor and hit a sizzling 50 per cent to turn back Florida State's cold Seminoles, 100-60, here last night.

Cashing in 43 field goals, the host Bulldogs stacked up a 57-34 halftime lead and hit their 100th point when Dick Wherry scored a free throw with 11 seconds left.

## HIGHEST EVER

It was the highest score ever recorded by a Citadel basketball team. Coach Norman Sloan's Bulldogs have a 14-7 record this season.

The Seminoles had one of their worst shooting nights, hitting only 26.6 per cent, on 25 field goals in 94 attempts. Now 8-14 this season, the Tribe had bowed to The Citadel by two points in an overtime period in Tallahassee last month.

FSU was handicapped when sophomore forward Dave Fedor left the court with four fouls with 5:12 to play in the first half. Fedor sat out about seven minutes in the second half, but still paced the Seminoles with 17 points and 18 rebounds.

Guard Jack Davis, who collected 11 points, was the only other Seminole in double figures.

The Bulldogs got hot-shooting efforts from forwards Ray Graves and Art Musselman, who scored 54 points between them,

only six less than the FSU team total. Graves got 28 points and Musselman 26.

FSU led early in the game, the last time at 14-13. It was 37-24 when Fedor left for the first time and the Bulldogs stretched their lead to 23 points at intermission.

The Bulldogs couldn't miss in the second half and increased the final margin to 40 points. The Tribe's worst previous loss this season was by 16 points to Memphis State.

It was the third straight 100-point game in which the Seminoles have been involved. Before last night's game, they had routed Rollins, 101-58, and downed Furman, 105-98.

Fedor's point average dipped slightly to 19.5 but his rebound average climbed a fraction to 15.7. FSU plays next at home, against Loyola of New Orleans next Monday night. Other games left are a road game with Miami and a season-ending home clash with Georgia.
