

ATHENS, Ga.—Florida State's scoring twosome of Dave Fedor and Ray Swain spurred a 71-62 basketball victory over Georgia here last night.

The victory, FSU's fourth over a Southeastern Conference team this season, boosted the Seminoles' record to 11-4. They'll take that standing into their outing

with rival Florida here Wednesday.

Fedor bagged 21 points and Swain 20.

The lead changed hands five times before Swain put the Seminoles ahead to stay, 13-12, in the early going. FSU led, 46-36, at the half.

Biggest first-half lead was 13 points with 5:02 to go. After intermission FSU was ahead by 16 points on three occasions.

With 1:44 left in the game, however, Georgia pulled within four points, at 66-62. But the Bulldogs' scoring was over for the night. Swain sank a free throw. Then Fedor dribbled the length of the court, hit for two points, was fouled, added another point from the free-throw line.

Carlton Gill led Georgia scoring with 19 points. Charles Adamek has 14, Harold Morris 13.

FSU hit 50.9 per cent of its field-goal tries, Georgia only 34.8 per cent.

Georgia is now 5-12 for the season.
