

Florida State poured it on Tampa 107-61 in a free wheeling, free fouling basketball game here Saturday night.

Except for the early moments, the winless Spartans, now 0-7, were never in the game.

Tampa stepped to a 7-3 lead. FSU went ahead to stay, at 10-9, with 4:01 gone.

It was 50-35 at halftime.

FSU was charged with 26 fouls and Tampa got nearly half its points at the free-throw line, sinking 23 of 34 shots. Nineteen fouls were charged against the Spartans, but FSU bagged just 13 of 22 attempts.

A sticky FSU defense held Tampa, a generally high scoring outfit, to one of its lowest totals recently. The Spartans sank only 27.7 per cent of their field-goal tries, just 15 of 54.

Meanwhile, FSU was having one of its better nights from the field, hitting 47 of 78 for 60.2 per cent, quite a step above the 38.8 per cent managed by the Tribe in its first five outings.

The Seminoles are now 2-4, with strong Tulsa coming up here Monday night. "Tulsa," says Coach Bud Kennedy, "probably has one of the finest teams that will have played here any time ever."

It will be a busy Christmas week for the Seminoles, who go into the Gator Bowl Tourney on Thursday.

Substituting liberally all the way, FSU outrebounded Tampa's depleted outfit, 78 to 50. The Spartans were minus scoring ace George Schary, who

broke an arm earlier this week.

Sophomore Gary Schull led the board work with 13 recoveries. He also racked 20 points, one less than the evening's high-point man, teammate Jerry Shirley. Nine rebounds were bagged by Shirley.

Three other Seminoles scored in double figures, Bill Peacock with 15, Cal Hoge 11, and Ken Leakey 10.

Tampa was sparked offensively by Chuck Andrews, 14 points, and Jim Stephenson, 13. Stephenson fouled out with 8:38 left. Andrews later followed him, along with Wayne Harden, who had nine points.

Tampa surprised FSU coaches by going with a man-to-man defense all the way, and the Seminoles worked it over.

FSU outscored Tampa 17-0 in a closing stretch, extending the final margin. The Tribe hit 100 points with 2:59 to play.
