

DELAND—Florida State's balanced attack came to the fore in the second half last night, enabling the Seminoles to defeat a scrappy Stetson basketball team, 80-60.

Budd Kennedy's cagers led 37 - 34 at halftime, but hit for 43 points after intermission to win their second game on the road this season. It was Stetson's eighth loss of the year, but only the second on its home court.

Florida State now stands 11-12 with Miami and Georgia left to play. The Seminoles invade the Miami Beach Convention hall for an 8:15 game with the Hurricanes tomorrow night.

Getting the usual well rounded point production throughout the lineup, the Seminoles put a tight defensive clamp on the high - scoring Hatters in the second half.

Jerry Shirley, 6-6 junior center, had one of his best nights from the floor, hitting 9 of 13 field goal attempts and two free throws to lead FSU with 20 points. Shirley also hauled in 12 rebounds to lead FSU in that department.

Pete Rogers hit 17 points and grabbed nine rebounds. Guard Bobby Lovell had 11 points,

ten of which came in the second half.

Gary Schull scored ten and Cal Huge nine for the Seminoles.

Stetson's Bill Hester, who set a Hatter school record of 45 points against Tampa last Saturday, got 26 last night to lead the Hatters.
